The IPA Board Disciplinary Tribunal of 14 November 2014 determined that the following case presented against the member was proven:

- a) Breached clause 98(2)(a) of the IPA Constitution as the member breached the IPA By-Laws in particular clauses 7.1.6 which constitutes a breach of clause 98(2)(h) of the IPA Constitution. The member has failed to comply with a reasonable request made by an Officer of the Institute as the member did not provide valid contact details which would allow the member to respond to letters from the Investigations Officer;
  - b) Breached clause 98(2)(h) of the IPA Constitution as the member failed to comply with a reasonable request made by an Officer of the IPA. The member has not responded to letters from the Investigations Officer;
- and
- c) Breached clause 98(2)(f) of the IPA Constitution as the member is guilty of conduct which is not in the best interests of the IPA. The above constitutes conduct that is not in the best interests of the IPA.

The Tribunal further resolved that Mr Paske's membership of the IPA is forfeited, and costs of \$550.00 and a fine of \$1000.00 are imposed.
